### **Theodore Julius**

**CC (1927):** B. Sept. 12, 1808, in Oberwinkel, near Waldenburg, Saxony; studied theology in Leipzig, 1827-32; after graduating, became attached to Pastor Stephan and refused to accept a position in the state church; emigrated with Stephan to America; his private secretary; took part in founding Concordia College; chief instructor until 1843; pastor of Trinity Congregation, New York; 1858 pastor of Holy Cross Church, St. Louis; resigned 1878; d. Sept. 24, 1881

**LC (1954):** has essentially the same info.

**LC (1975):** similar, but adds at the end: "assisted in teaching at Teachers' Sem., Addison, Ill., 1879-81."

### **Theodore, Sr., Ph. D.**

**CC (1927):** in body of book gives name only and refers to Roster [of Officers and Professors] at end of book. However, the Roster has only Theodore Charles (b. 1879), who was apparently son of Theodore, Sr., and Arthur.

**LC (1954):** B. Apr. 10, 1846, in New York City; educated Conc. Coll., St. Louis, later Ft. Wayne; grad. Conc. Sem., St. Louis, 1866; post-grad work New York U.; pastor at Immanuel, E. Boston, 1869; called to Northwestern Coll., Watertown, Wis., in 1871; prof. at Addison Teachers Seminary 1879-1913, when he retired; dir. Of Addison 1906-13; served Calif. Conc. Coll., Oakland, as instr. until 1925. D. Apr. 27, 1926.

**LC (1975):** Essentially the same, but identifies him as son of Theodore Julius

### **Theodore Charles**

**CC (1927),** in Roster of Officers and Professors at end: B. Nov. 23, 1879, at Addison, Ill.; graduated at St. Louis 1903; pastor in Detroit, Mich., 1903-9; president of Calif. Conc. College, Oakland, Cal., since 1909.

**LC (1954):** no listing

**LC (1975):** no listing

### **Arthur [C.]**

**CC (1927),** Roster at end: B. Apr. 8, 1882, at Addison, Ill.; grad. St. Louis 1905; pastor at Napa, Ca., 1905-12; at [St. John's,] San Francisco, since 1912; pres. of CA-NV Dist. since 1924.
